Every neighbor must feel that their family and home are safe from these types of random attacks. As a civic association, we will do everything necessary to condemn and stop this behavior from occurring again.

As a civic association consisting of members of different backgrounds, socio-economic status, national origins and races, we must work together to encourage and strengthen the common and core values of this neighborhood. We have a lot to be proud of in Olde Sawmill, and keeping our neighborhood safe and free from acts of violence and hatred benefits everyone in the long run. Simple acts like getting to know your neighbors, helping a senior citizen, watching out for each other’s children, organizing a block party and engaging random acts of kindness are little steps we can take to nurture a great community.

The civic association has reached out to the victim in this matter with offers of assistance, and may be asking for volunteers or donations to help.
